Kingstone's main source of supply is its own quarry, a large deposit of over 180,000 square meters. Located within ancient Roman mining sites, the quarry represents an exceptional added value for our business. The availability of its own resources guarantees the availability of materials as well as a complete knowledge of stone.

With the control of the extraction, the different qualities of material can be selected, traced and monitored throughout the supply chain, from the squaring of the block in the quarry to the installation of the finished elements.

Quality at Kingstone is integrated into a global system that involves all stages of the supply chain. The extraction of the raw material takes place in compliance with the international environmental protection standards UNI EN ISO 14001: 2015.

Transformation operations are managed according to the ISO: 9001 standards. All materials are certified according to the UNI EN 12058 and UNI EN 1469 standards.

Therefore, a stone that stands out not only for its purely decorative dimension but also offers excellent technical performance.





External Floors



Facades

Travertine is perfect for covering a facade. The external walls require materials that can withstand the elements: travertine is always the right choice for its natural elegance and proven invulnerability to external conditions. This is the reason why several iconic constructions of antiquity, still standing today, were built in travertine.

Processing steps



1

Extraction

The natural stone is extracted from the quarry in rough blocks, which are squared directly on site by single-wire or single-blade machines.



2

Transport

The square blocks are transported to the factory for sawing.



3

Sawing

The blocks are transformed into slabs of desired thickness by means of multi-blade saw.



4

Processing of the slabs

The slabs are grouted with cement or with special resins for the following phases.



5

Selection of the material

The customer chooses the material to be transformed and installed directly in the factory.



6

Cutting into formats

The slabs are transformed into the final "Cut-to_size" formats.



7

Installation

The correct installation of the material is essential to guarantee the maximum life of the stone in aesthetic and mechanical terms. In this phase the customer is assisted by providing, if necessary, the right protective product.

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
